Class Name: The Goodness Bowl with Mary Beth



The Goodness Bowl is designed with tall, upright sides that curve inward to hold even more small items and showcase more of the fabrics you love. Handcrafted using English Paper Piecing techniques. Each bowl is designed to be sturdy yet flexible. These bowls are so much fun to make and are ideal for organizing, gifting, decorating, and filling with treats, notions, and everyday essentials. Templates for 7 different bowl sizes are included in the pattern.

Techniques Taught:

- English Paper Piecing

Pattern / Book Required:

- So Treasured's The Goodness Bowl pattern by Jean Paccagnan

Fabric Required:

- Fabric (amount depends on bowl size chosen)
- Ultra firm stabilizer, fusible NOT recommended (amount depends on bowl size chosen)

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- Needles, thimble (if desired), scissors, sewing clips, etc for hand sewing
- Glue stick
- Cardstock or empty cereal or food boxes for making templates
- Fabric pen for tracing on fabric and stabilizer

Threads:

- Matching thread (patternmaker suggests polyester)

Pre-Class Preparation: Choose the bowl size you would like to make. Prepare a set of master templates of that bowl. Directions suggest first gluing cardstock to pattern pieces and then cutting out templates once affixed. For 1 bowl, you will need 2 hexagon templates and 2 petal templates.
