It is Fat Quarter friendly or perfect to make a big dent in your scrap bucket. It's modern design allows you to let your fabrics do the talking. The Confetti Quilt is simply machine pieced. It is NOT Foundation Paper Pieced.

Techniques Taught: Piece the Confetti quilt block with confidence! This is a forgiving block that allows you to focus on enjoying sewing and not the precision! If you're okay with points that DON'T align perfectly, this quilt is for you!

Pattern / Book Required: Confetti Quilt by Tied with a Ribbon

Class Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Tools & Supplies:

- Normal sewing supplies including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, 50 wt thread to match your fabric or a neutral color, pins, small scissors to trim threads, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade.
 - 1/4in. foot
 - Marking tool such as a mechanical pencil or chalk marker
 - You'll want your favorite ruler to cut your Fat Quarters (or scraps) – 6.5in. x 24.5in is perfect
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- Small portable iron and wool mat (Optional but very helpful)

Fabric Selection

Review your pattern for the fabric requirements. You can use 20 Fat Quarters and 3-1/4yards of background yardage. If you choose to make it scrappy, you'll need print pieces that are a minimum of 4in. x 7in. (And, you'll need 288 of them!) You'll also need background yardage.

We will cut the fabric for 8 blocks together in class!

Bring a bag lunch and water. (Or, there are a few spots to grab a bite nearby.)
