



Class Information and Supply List

Class Name: Hexie 2.0 – Putting It All Together with Mary Beth

Instructor: Mary Beth LaRosa

Techniques Taught:

- Attached hexies to each other to create a quilt
- Binding a hexie quilt without cutting any hexies already sewn

Pattern / Book Required:

- Hexies that have been completed with fabric

Fabric Required:

- Your choice of desired fabrics for a line of hexies creating a frame on the backing of the quilt. Bring a selection of fabrics you would like to work with. Fabrics should be larger than 6" x 6."

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- Thread in various colors to match your fabrics and/or a neutral like gray that will blend with all fabrics (to sew the hexies together)
- Hand quilting thread you are using for this project
- Various needles for hand sewing and hand quilting
- Sewing clips
- Scissors for cutting fabric and batting by hand
- Single hole punch from an office supply store (optional)
- Stiletto (optional)
- Glue stick (optional – for one way to prepare hexies if you are interested in that method)
- Any other sewing notions you like to use

Pre-Class Preparation:

- At least 10-15 completed single hexie units as learned in Hexie 1.0 class
- Your hexie top in one of the following conditions (all are acceptable, but you may get more out of the Hexie 2.0 class if you are further along) —
 - ** FINE — A group of hexies already sewn together. Do not remove papers from outermost hexies. Bring batting and backing.
 - ** VERY GOOD — A pieced hexie top with hexies along edges. Do not remove papers from outermost hexies. Bring batting and backing.
 - ** EVEN BETTER — An already basted quilt. Do not remove papers from outermost hexies.

** SUPERSTAR — Hand-quilted top (so it would be complete with batting and backing), BUT leave 2” of quilt top or 1 line of hexies at outer border **unquilted**. Do not remove papers from outermost hexies.
