Love Triangle is a modern and geometric Quilt design to make for someone you Love! Made using Equilateral Triangles, this 3-D style design is bold and looks great in both solids or print fabrics. You will learn how to accurately cut and piece 60° triangles, manage bias edges and match intersections.

Tools & Supplies:

- Normal sewing supplies including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, 50 wt thread to match your fabric or a neutral color, pins, small scissors to trim threads, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade.
- 1/4in. foot
- Marking tool such as a mechanical pencil or chalk marker
- You will need a 60 degree triangle ruler – I used the Tied with a Ribbon template set (available at CCF) and used the small triangle for the wall sized quilt. If you have another triangle ruler, be sure it has a blunt tip.
- Seam roller

- Small portable iron and wool mat (Optional but very helpful)

Fabric Selection

I suggest you review the pattern to better understand the color selection and amounts you need. You will need 8 fabrics plus your background. The eight fabrics should be four color families with a light and medium value of each. Make sure your colors contrast well with your background. (There is a coloring sheet in the pattern!) I will be demonstrating and sewing the small wall quilt. We won't finish the entire top in class but you'll be well on your way and have all the information you need to complete the top at home or during a CCF sew-in.

Bring a bag lunch and water. (Or, there are a few spots to grab a bite nearby.)
