Class Name: Nightingale Zipper Case

Instructor: Viv Lazich

Techniques Taught:

Working with quilted foam; installing zippers, boxing and binding a pouch, working with vinyl, machine binding.

Pattern / Book Required: Nightingale Pouch pattern by Center Street Quilts

Class Skill Level: Intermediate (Bag making experience)

Thoughtfully constructed, this versatile quilted case features four clear vinyl zipper pockets, allowing you to easily see and access your items. Two slip pockets provide additional storage for quick-grab essentials, while a spacious interior zipper pouch keeps bulky supplies secure and neatly tucked away.

Class Supplies:

Supply Requirements

Nightingale Zipper Case
 Finished Size: 8"w x 4"d x 6"h when closed
 8"w x 22"d x 4"h when open

Main Fabric *	1/2 Yard
Lining Fabric *	1/2 Yard
Accent Fabric *	1/2 Yard
Foam Stabilizer** or Batting	(1) 18" x 40" piece
Vinyl (12 or 16 gauge recommended)	(1) 16" x 16" piece
Webbing: (1" wide)	1 yard
Hardware	1" slider
Zippers ***	(3) 9" Zippers (1) 12" Zipper (1) 14" Zipper

* Non-directional prints work best.

** Foam Stabilizer such as Soft and Stable or Pellon Flex-Foam.

*** All zippers can be longer than measurements given and cut down to size if needed. Either #5 or standard #3 size zippers can be used. Nylon (plastic) zippers are recommended over metal zippers.

Additional Supplies: rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat, pencil or marking tool, scissors, safety pins or basting spray (such as Odif 505), and binding clips.

- Fabric, stabilizer, vinyl, hardware and zippers as required in pattern (see above).
 Consider purchasing a package of zippers by the yard!
- Topstitch needles
- Wonder clips
- Acrylic Ruler 24 1/2" x 6 1/2"
- Normal sewing supplies including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, 50 wt thread to match your fabric or a neutral color, pins, small scissors to trim threads, utility scissors for trimming the zippers, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade. • 1/4" foot, zipper foot and a walking foot if you have them
- Marking tool such as a mechanical pencil or chalk marker

Preparation Prior to Class

Following the pattern please complete **steps 1 – 4 quilting of main panel, pockets and zipper pouch**. You may quilt a half yard sandwich (you'll have some leftover). Cut and label your accent fabric pieces. **It is very important to have the quilted panel completed prior to class!**
