Techniques Taught: Discover how to create a stunning landscape quilt in this hands-on class. You'll learn how to arrange fabric like a puzzle, using color and placement to build depth and dimension. Explore easy raw-edge appliqué techniques and simple free-motion stitching that make the process approachable for all skill levels. Finally, you'll learn how to incorporate fibers to create a shimmering spring tree, adding texture and visual interest to your finished piece.

Pattern / Book Required: Purchase Pattern \$5 available in class.

Fabric Required:

- o 1 yard of very lightweight muslin
- o A variety of batik fat quarters or half yard cuts of black, greys and white/greys and greens for grass area.
- o 1 oz sample package of Angelina fibers: Key lime, peacock, lemon sparkle and enchanted forest flash

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- o Pencil
- o Freezer paper
- o 24X36 inch foam core board
- o Chalk wheel
- o 1 ½ yards of medium heat and bond
- o 1 small package of Water-Soluble Stabilizer (need a 10 square)
- o Light box if you have one. One will be available during class

Threads and Needles for Quilting:

- o 1 Superior Thread Magnifico Green to create trees



- o 2 Superior Thread Monopoly (crystal and smoke)
