Class Name: Make Your Own Jacket Class

Techniques Taught:

- Learning to use a garment pattern
- Garment sewing/fitting

Pattern / Book Required:

- Tamarack Jacket

Fabric Required:

- Yardage based on pattern measurements or
- Twin sized quilt, or larger if quilt has designs that are going to be fussy cut

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- Fabric scissors
- Paper scissors
- Rotary cutter
- Matching thread
- 1 ½" – 1 ¾" pins, minimum 100 count
- 5 yards ½" double fold bias binding premade or purchased
- ½ yard of fusible interfacing
- ½ yard of coordinating fabric for the pockets if using a quilt for the jacket
- Buttons, snaps, or hook and eyes – optional
