**Pattern / Book Required:**

- Purchase the pattern

**Fabric Required:**

- Background
  - 1 1/4 yard back-ground fabric (if not piecing)
  - Piecing background (6 different fabric 1/4 yard cuts)
    - 7 1/2 inches by WOF
    - 5 inches by WOF
    - 5 1/2 inches by WOF
    - 7 inches by WOF
    - 7 inches by WO
    - 6 inches by WOF
- Border
  - Inner border. 1/4 yard. Outer border: 1 1/4 yards
- An assortment of flowered fabrics with varying size flower
- 1 1/2 yards backing
- 1 1/2 yards batting

**Additional Supplies / Tools:**

- 3 yards of double sided fusible medium weight must have paper backing.
  - Example, heat and bond or steam to steam.
- Foam Core Board 36X48 (the thicker the better)
- 1 inch applique pins
- Rotary cutter
- Quilter's ruler
- Parchment paper or applique pressing sheet
- Pencil
- Stiletto or chop stick



- Scissors (paper and fabric)  
    o 4-inch small scissors with curved tip!
- Small iron and medium size wool mat
