**Class Name:** Collage Snowman

**Class Write up:**

Discover the art of fabric collage, where small, raw-edged pieces of fabric are cut, layered and fused in place to create a beautiful design — much like assembling a puzzle or mosaic. This creative technique allows you to experiment with color, texture, and pattern to form unique, expressive works of fabric art.

**Instructor:** Stacey Murren

**Techniques Taught:** Collage and free motion quilting.

**Pattern / Book Required:**

- Purchase the pattern and the kit if you are making the wall hanging.

**Fabric Required:**

- 1 yard back-ground fabric
- ¼ yard for bottom/ground to place the snowman
- An assortment of flowered fabrics with varying size flower, include snowflakes
- ½ yard black for hat, arms and buttons
- ½ yard for binding
- 1 ¼ yard backing
- ¼ of snowflake patterned fabric
- ½ yard border fabric
- 2 yards of double sided fusible medium weight must have paper backing.
- 1 1/2 yards batting

**Suggested Supplies / Tools:**

- Rotary cutter
- Quilter's ruler
- Freezer paper
- Parchment paper
- Pencil
- Pins
- Stiletto
- Scissors (paper and fabric)
  - Small scissors with curved tip!
- Small iron and wool mat
