Class Name: Hibiscus Beginning Thread Painting

Techniques Taught/write up:

This class introduces you to both thread painting and thread sketching for beginners. In this class you will learn the basics of free motion thread painting to create a design using straight and zigzag stitches.

Pattern / Book Required:

Fabric Required:

- 1 fat quarter, background fabric and binding
- 1 fat quarter border fabric
- 1 fat quarter backing
- 8"X8" pink fabric, for hibiscus
- 18"X18" batting

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- 12"X12" quilt sandwich (white on one side, black on the other for practicing stitches)
- Super slider, free motion slider (optional, but helpful for beginners)
- Quilting gloves
- Freezer paper
- Small sharp scissors and paper scissors
- Frixion pen
- 10"X10" heat and bond LIGHT
- Sewing machine

Thread: Superior Threads:

- Threads: bottom line, colors to match your background and border and backing fabric
- Magnifico, 2003 (white), 2008 (fuchsia), 2009 (light pink), 2059 (electric yellow), 2096
- Metallic, black and gold.

Needles:

- Micro sharp #8 and #10 and #12
- Metallic needle

Feet:

- Open toe free motion foot
