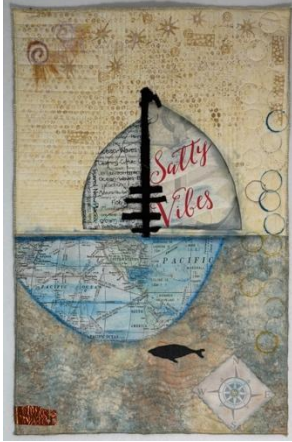

Class Information and Supply List

- **Class Name:** Painted Wave Sailboat Art Quilt



Instructor: Stacey Murren

Techniques Taught: Learn to create a mixed-media sailboat quilt that combines traditional piecing with raw-edge appliqué and free-motion quilting. You'll learn how to bring your image to life with the vibrant pigments of Inktense pencils and fabric paints. Watch as your sailboat transforms into a richly painted piece, bursting with color.

Pattern / Book Required: A kit is required and includes the pattern, 2 small containers for liquid, aloe vera, and parchment paper, wool for the whale, and a one-inch foam brush.

****Supply tool kits will be included in your class fee and will include all materials needed.**

Paint printing tools will also be available during class.

Fabric Required:

- o 1 Fat Quarter for sky
- o 1 Fat Quarter for the ocean
- o 1 Fat Quarter map fabric for boat
- o ¼ yd for the sails
- o 1/8 black
- o 1 yd for backing
- o 1 yard of Wool Batting

Supplies / Tools:

- o Freezer Paper
- o Basic Sewing Supplies
- o Inktense pencils (regular watercolor pencils will not work).
- o You can buy a small set or individual pencils. You will need two different blues, on black
- o Paint brush - Simply Simmons angular brush ¾" or similar
- o Creative Mark Scrubber watercolor brushes, set of 3-*recommended but not required*.
- o Jacquard - Lumiere and Neopaque set of paints



- o 1 One-inch foam brush
- o Paper towels
- o A fat quarter of old fabric or muslin to use as a drop cloth

Threads:

- o 1 spool of monopoly thread
- o 1 spool of 80 or 100 weight bobbin thread
