Class Name: Yuletide Blooms-A Tree Comes to Life

Class Write up: Transform three quilted panels into a dimensional Christmas tree — a stunning holiday piece that “pops out” from the wall or stands on its own. The panels transition from flat quilt art to a sculpted, realistic form — as though the fabric tree is emerging into real life.

Instructor: Stacey Murren

Techniques Taught: Manipulate fabric into 3D shapes, machine quilting, how to make mitered corners

Pattern / Book Required:

- Pattern and Kits available

Fabric Required:

- X5579-60 Hunter, 3 panels
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yards 1895-348 Lucy
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of 1895-178 Leaf
- 5/8-yard 1895-31 Emerald for binding
- 2 yards X5554-60 hunter for border
- 2 yards double sided fusible (heat and bond heavy)
- 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard backing (if you are having the piece quilted by Cotton Candy, make to add 5” on all sides of the backing)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard binding

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- Small rotary cutter
- Quilter’s ruler
- Spray starch
- Terial Magic
- 505 basting spray
- Pencil
- Pins (1 $\frac{3}{4}$ to 2 inches)
- Stiletto
- Scissors (paper and fabric)
 - Small scissors with curved tip!
- Foam Core board
- Small round bowl- cereal bowl size (6” from side to side)
- Walking Foot and Free motion foot



- Threads:
 - Piecing thread
 - Quilting thread to match poinsettias and leaves
 - Bobbin, Bottom line thread to match backing

Pre-Class Preparation ONLY CUT THE CENTER TREE PANEL TO SIZE
