Pattern / Book Required:

Sashiko patterns available during class

Fabric Required:

- 1/2 yard plain back-ground fabric
- Random pieces of fabric for patchwork
- 1 yard of Shape flex 101
- 3/4 yard for lining

Supplies / Tools:

- Quilters 10" or large square ruler
- 1 Sashiko thread 40m
- 1 tulip long Sashiko needle
- Tracing wheel sewing tool
- Saral Paper Corp Wax Free Transfer Tracking Paper Sampler Pack - One 8.5 Inches x 11 Inches
- Rotary cutter
