

Swim Rules to Remember

We want to make sure that you get the absolute best instruction from our swim instructors to give you the most out of your swimming lessons!

Safety First

We want you to enjoy your swimming lessons! Please follow these swim safety swim rules to ensure swim student safety while still having fun learning how to swim!

Parking

Our parking lot at the pool is small so please be aware of how much space your vehicle is taking up. Make sure to park off to the right side of the driveway and not directly in front of the gate or in front of the garage. Access must be open for emergency vehicles. Drive slowly and carefully, the parking lot can be crowded so watch out for young children. There is additional parking at the Ascuba Venture dive shop.

What to Wear

All swim students are to provide their own swimsuit as well as a towel. Any child under the age of 3 MUST wear a non-disposable swim diaper (available in store), even if they are potty trained. No chewing gum or wearing jewelry. Hair should be pulled neatly and securely away from the face so that it stays up for the entire class, no bows, bobby pins, or hair ornaments that may get lost in the pool. Personal items should be marked with a name. This facility's staff will not be responsible for any items that may be lost or stolen.

Make-up Policy

We do not offer make-up swim lessons as it disrupts the swimmer's schedule and makes it harder for them to learn consistently.

- Please give 24-hour notice. Otherwise, it is a no call/no show, and no credit will be issued.
- To credit any additional classes a Dr.'s note is needed.

Arrival & Pickup

To get the full benefit of your lesson, please arrive at least 5-10 minutes before (not earlier please) your scheduled class time. Your lesson will start and end promptly even if you are late. If you are more than 15 minutes late, the lesson can be canceled at the discretion of the swim instructor and will count as a no call/no show and no credit will be given.

Lesson Renewal

If you plan to renew your swim lessons, you will have five days past your last swim lesson date to renew.

Frozen Lessons

If you know that you will be unable to attend your swimming lessons for a period, there is the option to freeze them, and we will pause your swimming lessons with no loss of lessons. When you decide to resume your lessons, you will need to reschedule based on the current availability.
