

Mystery Quilt 2020

Week 3

Cut:

Color D - 1 - 1 ¾" WOF strip - **D**

Color E - 1 - 1 ¾" WOF strip - **E**

Color F - 1 - 1 ¾" WOF strip - **F**

Background - 3 - 1 ¾" WOF strip - **BK**

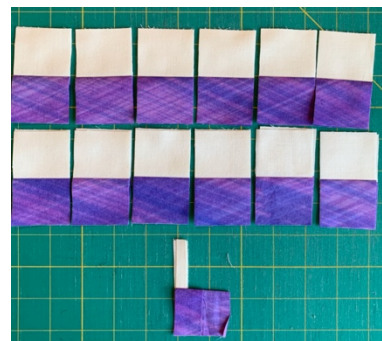
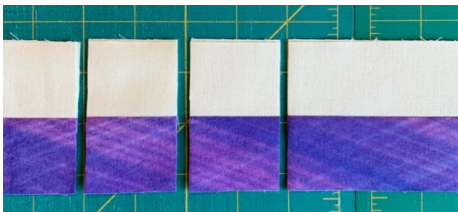
1. Cut all WOF strips in half before stitching because they are easier to keep straight when stitching and pressing. You will have some leftover after subcutting. Stitch a **BK** strip to both **D** and **E** strips, and one **F** strip. Press carefully to color.



2. Subcut each strip set into 1 ¾" units. You should have just enough fabric to get 24 from the **D/BK** strip set. The second picture shows how much I had leftover!!! 😊

Need: 24 - D/BK units
16 - E/BK units
8 - F/BK units

3. Stitch a **D/BK** unit to another **D/BK** unit with opposite colors together to make a four patch. Yield 12 – D/BK four patches. Repeat with **E/BK** units to yield 8 four patches. Repeat with **F/BK** units to yield 4 four patches. Press so there is a mini-four patch on the wrong side at the intersection.

Stitch

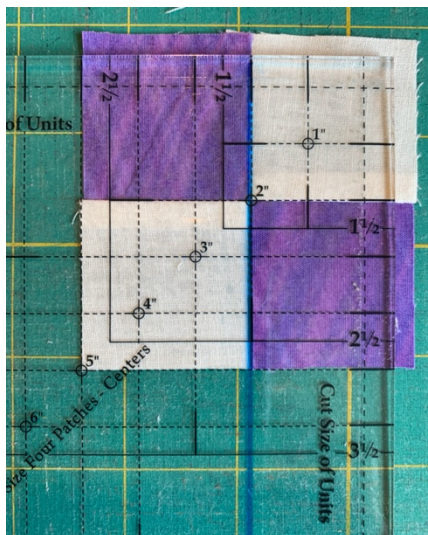


Press seam in opposite directions to get the mini- four patch in center



4. Trim all four patches to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". I used my Four Patch Square Up tool by Studio 180, but you can use whatever will give you an accurate trim.
