

Mystery Quilt 2020

Week 7

Cut:

Color E – 8 – 5 ¼” squares, cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles – **E7**

Color F – 8 – 4 ½” squares – **F7**

Background – 8 – 8 ½” squares – **BK11**
4 – 6 1/8” squares – **BK12**

1. Gather the eight **BK11** squares and the eight **F7** squares. On the wrong side of all of the **F7** squares, mark a line point to point on one diagonal. Place one **F7** in one corner of one **BK11** square and stitch just outside of the line.

2. Trim ¼” away from stitched line before pressing. Press to small triangle.

3. Gather the four **BK12** squares and the sixteen **E7** triangles. Stitch an **E7** triangle on opposite sides of each **BK12** squares. Stitch with the square on top for better visibility. Press to **E7**.

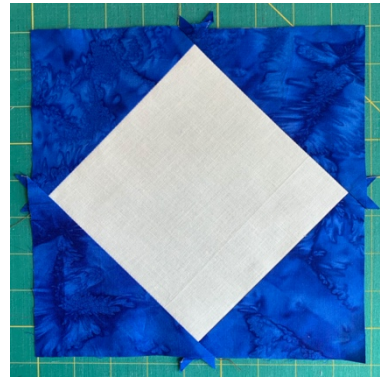


4. Stitch the remaining **E7** triangles to the open sides of the **BK12** squares, again stitching with the square on top for better visibility. Press to **E7**.

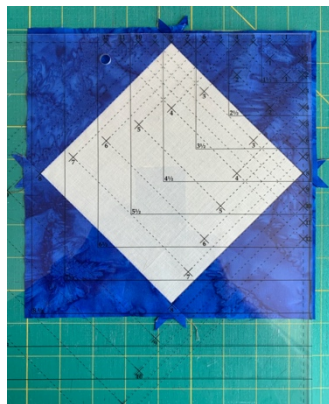

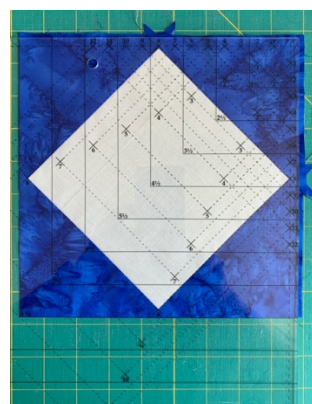


5. Trim each unit to $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". I used the Large Square Squared, Part B to get an accurate cut, but as always, use whatever you have. Yield – 4 units.

6. You have now completed all of the sections of the quilt. Next week we will assemble the whole quilt! 😊 Check below to be sure you have all of the pieces.

* Center – 24 ½” with colors A, B, C and Background

* 24 Snail Trail Blocks: 12 – D/BK

8 – E/BK

4 – F/BK

* 16 Arrow Units – 4 – D/BK

8 – E/BK

4 – F/BK

* 8 BK squares with F in one corner

* 4 Square in a Square Blocks – E/BK
