Skill detail - Advanced Beginner class for those who

- Have pieced and assembled several quilt tops.
- Are accurate in sewing a 1/4" seam and have rotary cutting skills
- Are comfortable with the process and are now ready to move on to more challenging techniques and projects using different techniques.

Supplies

Pattern - "French Roses" by Heather French

Template Plastic (optional)

Fine point permanent black marker for tracing pattern pieces onto template plastic (optional)

Sewing Machine in good working order, with power cord, foot pedal and Walking foot

Rotary cutter and small cutting mat

Sharp Fabric scissors

Temporary fabric marker of your choice

Thread to use for piecing top (neutral or color of choice) and for stitching Appliqué pieces

Normal sewing notions such as rulers, pins, snips and seam ripper

Fabric Requirements for 57 x 57 Quilt

You will need 2 2/3 yards for the background squares and outer border.

See the pattern for fabric requirements for Flowers, Inner Border & Binding, Leaves and backing. If you prefer, you can use scraps for the French Roses as I did in the quilt in the photo (a mix of Kaffe Fassett and Batiks). The pattern suggest five coordinating assorted fabrics for all layers of the flowers and a solid or tone on tone green for the leaves. I used a variety of Kaffe Fassett and Batik fabrics for my flowers. For the leaves, I used a variety of green batiks.

NOTE: Because this is raw edge Applique, fraying will occur therefore keep in mind that 100% cotton quilt fabric grays more than batik fabrics. I'm ok with that as I love batiks!

Pre Cutting Prior to Class

Follow the instructions in the pattern to cut the Background Fabric, cutting the border strips and 25 - 9.5" squares.
