

Make these mugs in your favorite color-scheme as a single for a placemat, two for a table mat. Want to go a little further? Add a Dresden plate. We'll be making one or two of the mugs in class. We can discuss how you will use yours and you will finish it at home.

Supplies:

-
- Pattern: Hot Cocoa by Laundry Basket Quilts
- Ruler (optional—only if you want to add Dresden Plates to your project): Tiny Dresden Plate Template by Suzn Quilts
- Cutting tools: mat, rotary cutter, rulers
- Sewing supplies/tools: thread to coordinate, usual supplies—pins, seam ripper, scissors, etc.
- Sewing machine with a quarter-inch foot or any foot that helps you sew a quarter-inch seam. Be sure to bring the power cord, foot pedal and any attachments that will be needed for piecing. You might want to bring the manual also—just in case you need it! You should know how to use your machine.
- Notebook and pen or pencil.
- Fabric: —5 quarter -yard cuts or FQs should be enough for the projects mentioned above. If you plan to make more for a quilt, then follow the pattern for quantities.
