

Bear Paw – 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished



1. Cut fabric as directed.

Background: 2 – 3" x 3" squares – **A1**
2 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares – **A2**

Contrast: 2 – 3" x 3" squares – **B1**
1 – 4 ½" x 4 ½" square – **B2**

2. Half Square Triangle Units.....yes, we are making them again!! 😊 Gather the two **A1** squares and mark a line ¼" away from both sides of one diagonal. Match each **A1** with a **B1** and stitch on, or just inside, both marked lines.

3. Cut between the diagonals and press toward the darker fabric.

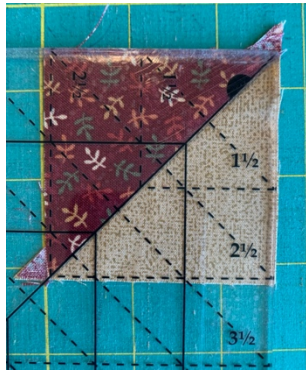

4. Trim all four squares to $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ using the Tucker Trimmer 1, or whatever tool you like to use.

5. Gather the **A2** piece and the **B2** piece. Assemble block as shown. Press seams open to reduce bulk. Bear Paw is ready for the setting block of your choice! ☺
