Bear Paw-61/2" x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished


1. Cut fabric as directed.

2. Half Square Triangle Units. $\qquad$ yes, we are making them again!!
© Gather the two A1 squares and mark a line $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of one diagonal. Match each A1 with a B1 and stitch on, or just inside, both marked lines.

3. Cut between the diagonals and press toward the darker fabric.

4. Trim all four squares to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ using the Tucker Trimmer 1, or whatever tool you like to use.

5. Gather the $\mathbf{A} \mathbf{2}$ piece and the $\mathbf{B 2}$ piece. Assemble block as shown. Press seams open to reduce bulk. Bear Paw is ready for the setting block of your choice! ©
