Block #10

1. Cut fabric as shown.



Main Fabric 1

Cut 1 - 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ square, then cut once diagonally

Cut 1 - 5 1/2" square, then cut once diagonally

Cut 4 - 2 1/2" squares

Main Fabric 2

Cut 1 - 3 1/2" square, then cut once diagonally

Cut 1 - 5 1/2" square, then cut once diagonally

Cut 4 - 2 1/2" squares

Coordinating/Contrast Fabric

Cut 1 - 5 1/2" square

Background Fabric

Cut 4 - 4 ½" squares

Cut 1 - 3 3/8" square (it must be 3 3/8")

Cut 1 - 5 1/2" square

2. Corner units. Gather the four $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares and two Main 1 and 2 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Mark a diagonal line from tip to tip on all four small squares. Place one small square in the corner of each large background square and stitch just to the outside of the marked line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press to background.








3. Non-Mirror Combo units. Gather the 5 ½" square from background and coordinating fabric. On the wrong side of the background square, mark two lines ¼" away from the diagonal on both sides. It's going to get funky again like it did in our very first block! You will NOT be sewing on all of the lines. Stitch down the right side of the diagonal to the middle, cross over to the left and continue stitching to the bottom. Rotate to the other diagonal and repeat.



4. Cut between diagonal lines. Press to the coordinating fabric. Match pieced triangle with a Main 1 or a Main 2 triangle and stitch carefully along the long edge. You are handling a lot of bias here, so be gentle! Press to large triangle.



5. Trim these units to 4 1/2". Of course I used my Tucker Trimmer 1!!! \odot

6. We aren't finished with these units quite yet. Gather the remaining 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from the Main 1 and Main 2 fabrics. Mark one diagonal line from tip to tip on each square. Place one square on the opposite solid corner of each combo unit. Stitch just outside the marked line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press <u>away</u> from small triangle.

7. Square in a Square unit. Gather 3 3/8" background square and two Main 1 triangles. Stitch triangles on opposite sides of the square. Just basically center the triangle and sew with the square on top for better visibility. (I accidentally flipped this one upside down for the picture, the square should be on the top) Press away from the center.

8. Repeat with the Main 2 triangles.

9. Trim to 4 1/2". Yes, I used my Tucker Trimmer 1!

10. Assemble block as shown. Press seams open. It should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
