

## Block #3

1. Cut fabric as shown.



Main Fabric

Cut - 4 - 5" squares

Cut - 1 - 4 1/2" square

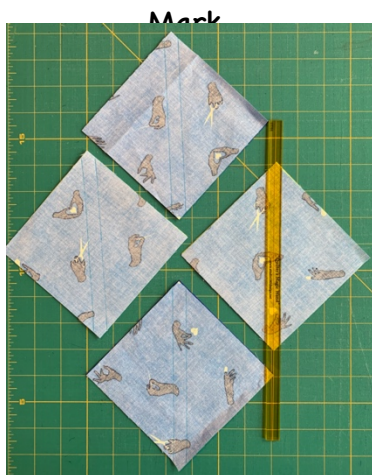
Star Fabric

Cut - 2 - 5" squares

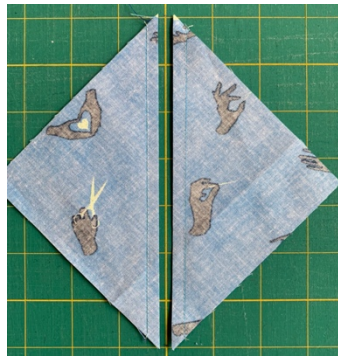
Background Fabric

Cut - 2 - 5" squares

2. On the wrong side of the four main fabric 5" squares, mark lines on both sides of the diagonal  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal. Match with the two 5" Star squares and the two background squares. I used my Quilter's Magic Wand, but you can use any tool that will give you accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ " lines. Stitch on or just barely inside these lines.

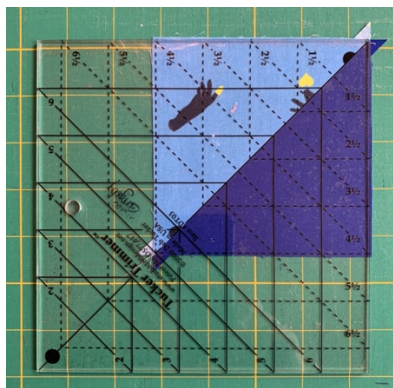


3. Cut between the diagonals. Press all seams open.

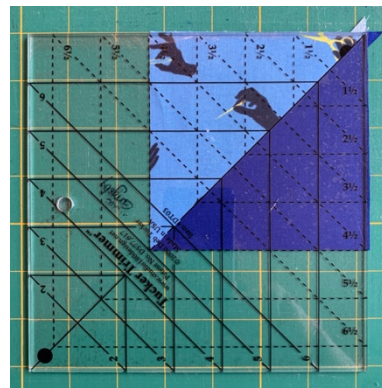


4. Trim all eight squares to 4 1/2". I used my Tucker Trimmer 1 to get super accurate cuts, but you can use whatever tool you have to get an accurate trim.

5. Assemble block as shown. Press all seams open. It should measure 12 1/2".
