
Block #6

1. Cut fabric as shown.




2. Large Half-Square Triangle units – Gather the Main 1 and Main 2 fabric 5" squares. Mark a line ¼" away from each side of one diagonal. I use the Quilter's Magic Wand to make the lines, but you can use whatever you have to make accurate lines. Stitch on, or just inside both lines. Press seams open.




3. Trim to 4 ½". I use the Tucker Trimmer 1 for easy, accurate trim ups.

First Trim




Second Trim




4. Small Half-Square Triangle units – Gather the two 6" squares. Mark a line ¼" away from each side of one diagonal. Repeat with the other diagonal. I use the Quilter's Magic Wand to make the lines, but you can use whatever you have to make accurate lines. Stitch on, or just inside all four marked lines.

Mark and Stitch




5. Cut this square into eight sections starting with the VERTICAL and HORIZONTAL lines first. Measure in 3" from edge and cut vertically. Do not move the square. Cut horizontally, still not moving the square. Then cut between both diagonals. Press seams open.


Vertical



Horizontal




Both Diagonals




6. Trim all eight squares to 2 ½". The Tucker Trimmer 1 works great!!! ©

7. Assemble four corner units as shown. Press seams open.



8. Assemble block as shown. Press seams open. It should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
