1. Cut fabric as shown.




Main Fabric

Cut 8 - 2 ½" squares


2. Quarter Square units. Gather the two main and two background 5 ½" squares. Mark two lines ¼" away from one diagonal. You know that I use my Quilter's Magic Wand for this step! © Stitch on, or just inside, the marked lines. Cut between diagonals. Press seams open.




3. On the wrong side of two of the completed squares, mark two lines 1/4" away on either side of one diagonal, crossing over seam line. Pair marked square with an unmarked one, wrong sides together with opposite colors together. Stitch on, or just inside, the marked lines. Cut between the diagonals. Press seams open. Full disclosure, the pictures don't show them pressed open. I took the pics first, then did the typing. Press them open!! $\ \odot$


Mark Stitch and Cut






4. Trim these four squares to 4 1/2". Hint: Tucker Trimmer 1






5. Assemble corner and center Four Patches as shown. Press seams open.







6. Assemble block as shown. Press seams open. It should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
