## Bow Tie - $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished



1. Cut fabric as directed. You can make both bow ties the same color if you want! :)

& 2-212^{\prime \prime} \times 21_{2 \prime \prime}^{\prime \prime} \text { squares - B2 }
\end{array}

Contrast \#2: $2-1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{2}$ squares - C1
$2-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares - C2
2. Gather the two $\mathbf{B 1}$ squares and the two $\mathbf{C 1}$ squares and mark a line from corner to corner on one diagonal. Gather three A's. Stitch one B1 to one A, stitch one C1 to one A and stitch one B1 and one C1 to opposite corners of one $\mathbf{A}$. Stitch on or just outside marked line.

B1 to A
B1 and C1 to A
C1 to A

3. Trim all seams to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press to the contrast fabric.

4. Gather the two remaining A squares, the two B2 squares and the two C2 squares. Assemble the block as shown. Press seams to contrast when assembling rows. Press seams open when combining the rows. You are ready for your setting block! ©
