

Bow Tie – 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished



1. Cut fabric as directed. You can make both bow ties the same color if you want! 😊

Background: 5 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares – **A**

Contrast #1: 2 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares – **B1**
2 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares – **B2**

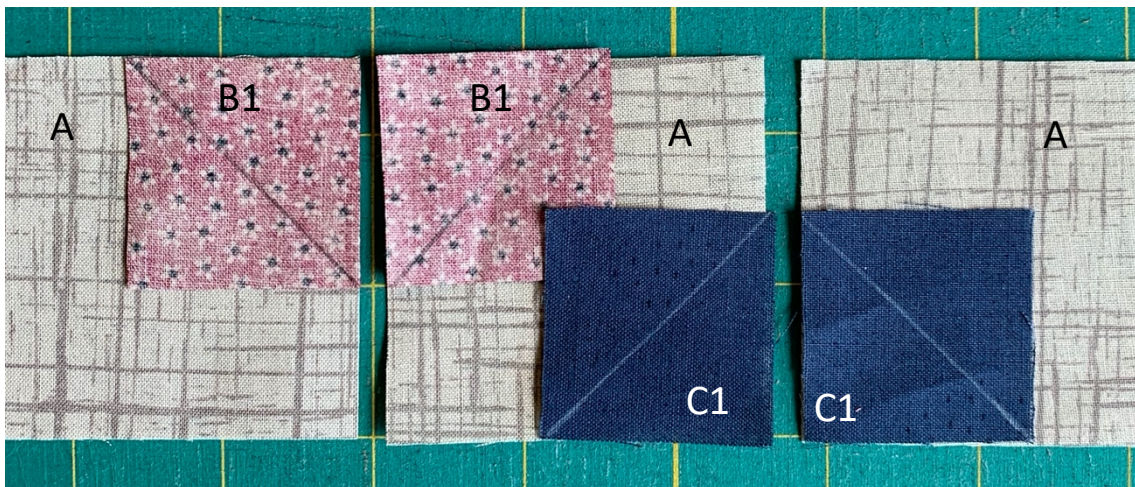
Contrast #2: 2 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares – **C1**
2 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares – **C2**

2. Gather the two **B1** squares and the two **C1** squares and mark a line from corner to corner on one diagonal. Gather three **A**'s. Stitch one **B1** to one **A**, stitch one **C1** to one **A** and stitch one **B1 and** one **C1** to opposite corners of one **A**. Stitch on or just outside marked line.

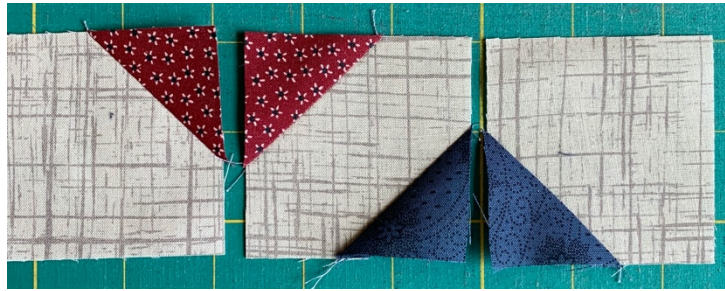
B1 to A

3. Trim all seams to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press to the contrast fabric.



4. Gather the two remaining **A** squares, the two **B2** squares and the two **C2** squares. Assemble the block as shown. Press seams to contrast when assembling rows. Press seams open when combining the rows. You are ready for your setting block! 😊
