## Crow's Nest - $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished



1. Cut Fabric as directed.
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Background: \(2-3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}\) squares - A1
    \(1-1 \times 12^{\prime \prime}\) strip - A2
    \(1-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\) square - A3
Contrast: \(\quad 2-3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}\) squares - B1
    \(2-1 \frac{11 / 4}{}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}\) strip - B2
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2. Half Square Triangle Units.....yep!!! Gather both A1 squares and mark a diagonal line $1 / 4 / 1$ away from both sides of one diagonal. Match each A1 with a B1 and stitch on or just inside the marked lines. Cut between the diagonals. Press toward the dark.

3. Trim all six squares to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. I use the Tucker Trimmer 1 , but you can use whatever tool you have.


Second Trim

4. Gather the three B2 strips and stitch together with the background in the middle. I used a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam for this and measured across when I finished pressing to make sure it was $\underline{\mathbf{2} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ across. Press to the dark. Then subcut into four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sections.

Stitch strips together, then subcut

5. With the remaining A3 square, assemble the block as shown. Press all seams open. You are now ready for your setting block! :)
