## Crow's Nest - 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished



1. Cut Fabric as directed.

Background: 2-3" x 3" squares - A1

1 – 1 x 12" strip – **A2** 

1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square – **A3** 

**Contrast**: 2 - 3" x 3" squares - **B1** 

2 - 1 1/4" x 12" strip - **B2** 

2. Half Square Triangle Units.....yep!!! Gather both **A1** squares and mark a diagonal line ¼" away from both sides of one diagonal. Match each **A1** with a **B1** and stitch on or just inside the marked lines. Cut between the diagonals. Press toward the dark.

3. Trim all six squares to 2 ½" x 2 ½". I use the Tucker Trimmer 1, but you can use whatever tool you have.

4. Gather the three **B2** strips and stitch together with the background in the middle. I used a scant ¼" seam for this and measured across when I finished pressing to <u>make sure it was</u> 2 ½" across. Press to the dark. Then subcut into four 2 ½" sections.

5. With the remaining **A3** square, assemble the block as shown. Press all seams open. You are now ready for your setting block! ©
