

Jewelry Roll-up

Materials

9 x 21" fabric piece for body

9 x 10 1/4" batting or flannel

9 x 11" coordinating fabric for pockets

3/4 yard of ribbon

Fold body fabric in 1/2 and press to make 9 x 10 1/2". Open and position the batting on the wrong side of the bottom 1/2 of body, using the pressed line as your top guide. Pin in place to bottom layer only.

Cut the pocket fabric in half to get 2 pieces 9 x 5 1/2" each. Fold each in half and press with right sides out to make 2 pockets that are 9 x 2 3/4".

On the body fabric measure up from bottom 1" and mark a line. Place the raw edges of one pocket piece on the line with edges towards the top. Pin in place then sew 1/4" in from edges on line.

Flip pocket up -folded edge is now toward top- press. Mark a line where the pocket top hits the body. Flip first pocket down and pin second pocket on marked line and sew as before. Flip each pocket up and press in place. Pin sides of pockets in place.

Next, fold body fabric so that right sides are together (pockets will be inside). Sew 1/4" around edges leaving 2 to 3 inches open in center bottom. Trim the batting from the 1/4" and trim corners. Turn inside out and fold open edges in and press flat.

Finish with decorative top stitching around edges. Use a straight or decorative stitch to make divisions in pockets to hold jewelry pieces separate.

On the outside top find the center point and pin ribbon at center spot in ribbon, attach with zigzag stitch.
