

Ribbon Tie Holder

Materials needed-

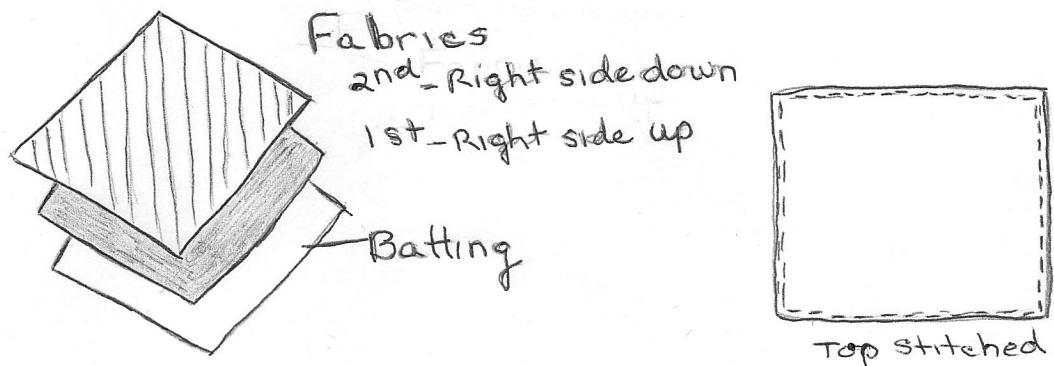
2 fat quarters that go together (Using smaller pieces, like a layer cake piece is possible)

Batting

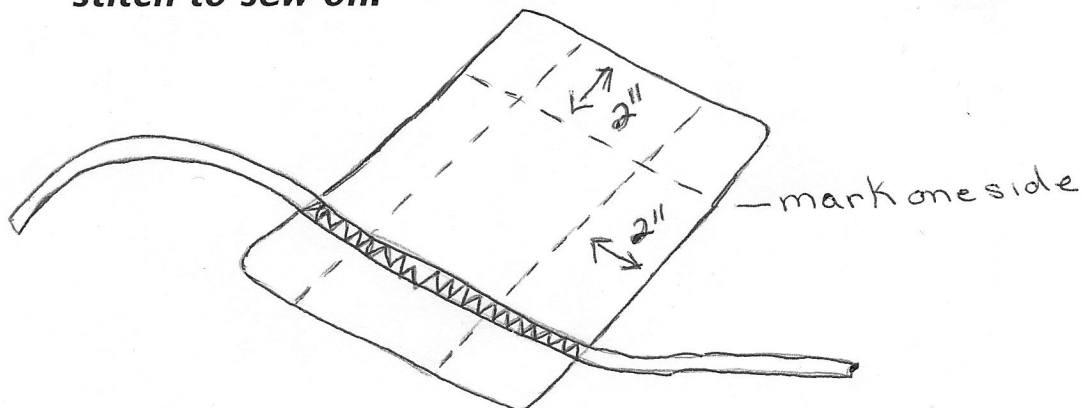
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards ribbon

Cut 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from each fabric and batting

Layer batting, 1st fabric right side up, then 2nd fabric right side down. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam around outside leaving about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " opening. Trim away the $\frac{1}{4}$ " batting and trim the corners. Turn right side out, fold in the open edges and press. Sew a finishing stitch $\frac{1}{8}$ " in from edge.



Decide which side to sew ribbon on and mark lines 2" in from each side. Pin on one ribbon at a time and use zig-zag stitch to sew on.



Fold up sides and tie bows on each corner.
