Project: T-shirt quilt with sashing & cornerstones Size: 56" x 73" (approximately)

2 sessions

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For this class, you should have experience making quilts, know how to sew a 1/4" seam, know how to use a rotary cutter, rulers, etc.

First Session: In the first session you'll be getting the shirts ready for the quilt top and we'll discuss the fabric you'll need for sashing, cornerstones and the border.

- Basic cutting supplies: rotary cutter, mat, ruler(s), scissors, etc.
 - Ruler: a square ruler that allows at least a half inch all around the largest design on all of the shirts. I use a 16 1/2" square ruler. A slotted ruler will NOT work for this class.
- Fusible, lightweight interfacing such as Shape-Flex or French-Fuse.
 - 3 yards if it's 45" wide —OR—
 - 6 yards if it's 17-20" wide
- T-shirts. 9 to 12 shirts. Please bring the whole shirt; we'll cut them in class.
- Notebook and pen or pencil.
- Basic sewing supplies
- 2 18" square press cloths (I use muslin)

Second session: In the second session you'll start to put the quilt together.

- Basic cutting supplies: rotary cutter, mat, ruler(s), scissors, etc.
- T-shirts backed with stabilizer and cut to size
- Sashing and cornerstone fabrics cut and ready to sew with the T-shirts
- Sewing machine with a straight stitch foot. Be sure to bring the power cord, foot pedal and any attachments that will be needed for piecing. You might want to bring the manual also—just in case you need it! You should know how to use your machine.
- Notebook and pen or pencil.
- Basic sewing supplies
- Fabric already cut for sashing and cornerstones

Note: lay out the shirts the way you want them in the quilt and take a photo that you can refer to during class.
