### **Local Delivery**

As a reminder, deliveries are conducted Monday-Saturday 12pm-6pm only. Any orders received after these hours will be added to the next delivery day. For special delivery instructions, please use the “notes” section during checkout – for example, call before delivering, security gate code, deliver to mailbox/front door/side door/etc.

The nearby road construction has been a major problem in conducting deliveries. Therefore, we ask customers, who are further away, please put in your delivery request prior to 2pm.
