# FLATS™ - BOY CLOTHES

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## Printable Instructions for use with Fusible Interfacing

### MATERIALS:

Hook/rough side of 3/4" or 2" wide Velcro™, Stabilizer: ByAnnie's Soft and Stable™ OR fusible fleece, fabric.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Read all instructions first. Loosely cut out shapes.
- 2) Fuse shapes to WRONG side of fabric.
- 3) Contrast the bobbin thread to right side of fabric. Stitch embellishing lines from the interfacing side, so bobbin thread will show on right side of fabric. Suggested stitches: straight, stretch or zigzag. Pigma pens and a light box can be used to transfer embellishing lines, too.
- 4) Cut shapes along outer solid lines.
- 5) Cut a piece of fabric (for the backside) and a piece of stabilizer (for the inside) slightly larger than the clothing piece.
- 6) Zigzag a 1/2" x 2" (or less) Velcro hook/rough piece to the outer (right-side of fabric) of the Back: positioning it so that it will line up with the Velcro that is on the doll body (For example: at waist for pants, underarms for shirts).
- 7) Sandwich stabilizer between Front and Back, with right sides of fabric facing out.
- 8) Straight stitch around clothing piece close to the raw edge, through all layers.
- 9) Trim inside/back even with front.
- 10) Using a wide zigzag (2.5 mm-3.0mm width) and a short length (1.0-1.5 mm length), stitch around all raw edges, pivoting around curves and points. Play!
