QCR (Quick Curve Ruler) Tree

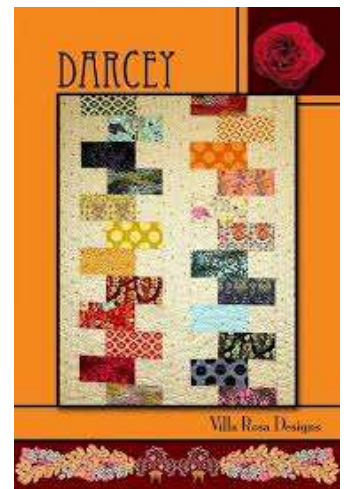
