



Class: Clarissa Quilt

Items needed for class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe (fabric, patterns, rulers, books, specialty thread, etc.) If you have basic sewing supplies that are not listed below, please bring them.

Class Description:

Looking for a fast and easy way to feature your favorite fabrics? Clarissa is the quilt for you!

For beginners and beyond, this pattern will become one of your favorites. Choose any layer cake that you love and an accent color to contrast. In class, we will make a few blocks and then play with the endless setting possibilities.

Using the Stripology Squared Ruler from GE will help to increase your accuracy and efficiency.

Supplies:

- Clarissa pattern by GE Designs
- Any layer cake. Dorinda used all 42 squares for the sample size.
 - The pattern calls for 48 blocks for a lap size measuring 57 x 76. If you want this larger size, you will need to purchase ½ yard of two additional prints to add to your layer cake.
- 1 ¼ yards of an accent color
- ¾ yards for binding
- 3 ¾ yards for backing
- Neutral thread
- Stripology Squared Ruler is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** and will be used for future classes
- Optional: ruler with at least a length of 18" PLUS another ruler for squaring up a Perfect 10 or a 12.5" square ruler
- GE Ruler Stickers
- Rotary Cutter with **new** blade (the 60 MM size works best for this ruler)
- Cutting Mat
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Sewing Machine in good working order with quarter inch foot

Pre-Class Instructions:

- From the accent fabric:
 - Cut two 15" wide strips.
 - Sub cut forty 2" x 15" rectangles

The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- To reserve a spot in a class, you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration.
- Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee.
- Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior to class.
- Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class.
- Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, books, rulers). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts.
- You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- If you are unable to make class and you cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor later.
- There are no refunds for NO SHOWS.
- Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified & all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- Patterns, books and handouts cannot be shared or photo-copied due to copyright laws.
- Guests are not allowed in classroom.
- All machine brands are welcome in our classroom.
- A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at time of registration if you'd like to use one of our machines.
- Your Sewing Machine must be in good working order and you need to know how to thread it and operate it (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend "borrowing one from a friend who hasn't used it for years!" Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate it. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.

BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES are listed as follows, but not limited to:

1. Scissors, pins, seam ripper, pen, paper, needles, thread, ruler, and thread. If you have supplies at home, bring them.
2. **Specialty items needed for class such as a pattern, book, fabric, rulers, etc., must be purchased at The Cotton Blossom. Please make every effort to have supplies purchased prior to class.**
3. We pledge to do our best to make sure your project is a complete success!

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak we have new additional class policies:

1. Please bring your machine through the double glass doors that enter the classroom (not the main entrance)
2. Please be in good health and not having been exposed to anyone that has been sick.
3. Please wash your hands when you arrive and before you leave.
4. Please always wear a face mask (no exceptions) and avoid touching your face while in class.
5. The instructor will not wear a mask while lecturing but will be distanced away for all customers. If individual attention is needed, the instructor will apply a face mask.
6. Please be able to distance yourself from everyone by 6 feet. Our classroom is large and can accommodate many students seated over 6 feet apart.
