



Class: Brooke's Quackin Quilters Salsa Class

Class Fee: \$50

Skill Level: Easy

Items needed for class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, patterns, rulers, books, specialty thread, etc). If you have basic sewing supplies and they are not listed below, please bring those (pins, scissors, seam ripper, needles, thread, etc.).

Class Description: Everything is Just Ducky! Because we just keep paddlin' along. Come to class and collect a duck! Finish a top – collect another!

We will be working on Villa Rosa Patterns AND 5 Yard quilts from the Fabric Cafe Step it Up book throughout 2026.

In February 2026 we will be making the Salsa Quilt from the Step it Up book. Our goal in class will be to master the Bloc Loc ruler, and to finish at least one of each of the blocks needed for the quilt.

Supplies Needed:

Step it Up 5 Yard Quilts book from Fabric Café

5 – 1 yard cuts as per the pattern directions for quilt blocks and borders

1 – half yard cut for traditional binding OR 2 half yard cuts for Brooke's Faux Flange Binding
Thread to match/complement

Rotary cutter with a fresh blade

Stripology ruler is highly recommended for the homework cutting

4 ½" or larger Block Loc ruler or other square ruler to be used to square up HSTs

12 ½" Square Ruler for squaring up blocks

Rotating Cutting Mat

Baggies to separate, label and sort pieces into.

Marking utensil

12" ruler to mark diagonal lines with and to help with cutting HSTs apart.

Pins/Clips

Seam Ripper

Iron and wool pressing mat (suggested but not required)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From Fabric #1:

- Cut 2, 6½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 12, 6½" x 6½" squares for **Block "B" Assembly**
- Cut 1, 6½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 5, 6½" x 6½" squares for **Block "B" Assembly**. From the remainder of this strip, cut 1, 2½" x 6½" for **Border #3 Extension**.
- Cut 6, 2½" x WOF for border #3

From Fabric #2:

- Cut 8, 3½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 48, 3½" x 3½" squares for **HST-1 Assembly** and 34, 3½" x 3½" squares for **HST-2 Assembly**
- Cut 2, 3" x WOF; from these strips, cut 24, 3" x 3" squares for **Unit "A" Assembly**

From Fabric #3:

- Cut 4, 3½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 34, 3½" x 3½" squares for **HST-2 Assembly**
- Cut 2, 3" x WOF for **Strip Assembly**
- Cut 6, 1½" x WOF for border #1
- Cut 4, 1¼" x WOF for binding

From Fabric #4:

- Cut 4, 3½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 44, 3½" x 3½" squares for **HST-1 Assembly**
- Cut 1, 3½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 4, 3½" x 3½" squares for **HST-1 Assembly**. From the remainder of this strip, cut 9, 3" x 3" squares for **Unit "A" Assembly**
- Cut 3, 3" x WOF; from these strips, cut 15, 3" x 3" squares for **Unit "A" Assembly** and 24, 3" x 3" squares for **Unit "B" Assembly**
- Cut 4, 1¼" x WOF for binding

From Fabric #5:

- Cut 2, 3" x WOF; from these strips, cut 24, 3" x 3" squares for **Unit "B" Assembly**
- Cut 4, 1½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 24, 1½" x 5½" rectangles for **Block "A" Assembly**
- Cut 4, 1½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 12, 1½" x 11½" rectangles for **Block "A" Assembly**
- Cut 3, 1½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 34, 1½" x 3" rectangles for **Unit "C" Assembly**
- Cut 1, 1½" x WOF for **Strip Assembly**
- Cut 1, 1½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 6, 1½" x 6½" rectangles for **Block "C" Assembly**
- Cut 6, 1½" x WOF for border #2

From Backing Fabric:

- Cut 2, 90" x WOF

The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- 1) To reserve a spot in a class you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration.
- 2) Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee.
- 3) Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior to class.
- 4) Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class. * Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, books, rulers). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts.
- 5) You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund (your choice of a refund or store credit). If you are unable to make class and you cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor later.
- 6) Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified & all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- 7) Patterns, books, and handouts cannot be shared or photo-copied due to copyright laws.
- 8) Guests are not allowed in the classroom.
- 9) All machine brands are welcome in our classroom.
- 10) A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at the time of registration if you'd like to use one of our machines.

11) Your Sewing Machine must be in good working order, and you need to know how to thread it and operate it (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend “borrowing one from a friend who hasn’t used it for years!” Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate it. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.

*BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES: Scissors, pins, seam ripper, pen, paper, needles, thread, ruler, and thread. If you have supplies at home, bring them. Specialty items needed for class (pattern, book, fabric, ruler) must be purchased at The Cotton Blossom. Please make every effort to make supply purchases prior to class.
