*Items needed for the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, pattern, rulers, specialty thread, book, etc.). If you have basic sewing supplies, and they are not listed below, please bring them. (pins, scissors, seam ripper, needles, thread, etc.)*

Class Description: Store and carry all your project pieces or supplies in this handy zippered bag with attached handle. Fabric quilted with Soft and Stable makes a sturdy base, and the mesh front affords great visibility of contents with a bit of added stretchiness.

\*Pattern will be provided in class.

#### **Supplies Needed:**

- Sewing machine
- Fabric – 3 fat quarters or ¼ yard cuts in coordinating prints/colors
- ByAnnie's Soft & Stable – 13" x 18" piece
- Lightweight mesh fabric 8.5" x 17" piece
- Zipper – 24" single slide handbag zipper
- Thread - to match fabrics

#### **Homework - Cut materials:**

- From main fabric –  
Back main (to be quilted in class) 13" x 18"  
Front border 3" x 17"
- From lining fabric –  
Back lining (to be quilted in class) 13" x 18"  
Border lining 3" x 17"
- From coordinating (trim) fabric –  
Bias binding 13.5" x 13.5"  
Handle 4" x 12"
- From ByAnnie's Soft & Stable –  
Back stabilizer 13" x 18"
- From fusible interfacing (SF101 Pelion Shape Flex) –  
Border interfacing 3" x 17"  
Handle interfacing 4" x 12"
- From mesh fabric –  
Mesh front 8.5" x 17"

The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- 1) To reserve a spot in class, you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration.
- 2) Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee.

- 3) Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior to class.
- 4) Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class. \*Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, rulers, books). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts.
- 5) You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund. (You will have a choice of a refund or store credit.) If you are unable to make class and you do not cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor at a later date.
- 6) There are no refunds for NO SHOWS.
- 7) Most classes have a minimum enrollment of 3 students. If the class is canceled due to low enrollment, you will be notified and all course fees will be returned in full. (your choice of a refund or store credit)
- 8) Patterns, books, and handouts cannot be shared or photocopied due to copywriter laws.
- 9) Guests are not allowed in the classroom.
- 10) All machine brands are welcomed in our classroom.
- 11) A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at time of registration if you would like to use one of our machines.
- 12) Your sewing machine must be in good working order, and you need to know how to thread it and operate it. (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend borrowing one from a friend who hasn't used it in a while. Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate machines. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.
