

## FLOATING WINDOWS QUILT

56 X 72

Level: Beginner and Beyond

Floating Windows is a wonderful and fast pattern to “show off” your favorite quilting prints. Simple blocks constructed well nest easily together. This one will become one of your “go-to” favorites. Great review of seam allowances and pressing tips.

### Supplies Needed:

Floating Windows pattern by Boho Blanket

1  $\frac{3}{4}$  yards background fabric

1  $\frac{3}{4}$  yards accent and binding fabric

Twelve  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard cuts OR Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard cuts of focus fabrics

Thread that matches background

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic Sewing Supplies

Best Press

Cutting Mat and Rotary Cutter

12.5” square ruler

6.5” x 24” long ruler OR

16.5” Square ruler (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED)

Pre-Class Homework: This is the cutting for the whole quilt. If you can do it all before class, then the sewing will be easy. If you cannot, then do a few of each size. Place all the different sizes into labeled baggies, please.

From the Background:

Cut three 4.5” WOF strips. Subcut (24) 4.5” squares

Cut two 2.5” WOF strips. Subcut (12) rectangles 2.5” x 6.5”

Cut three 2.5” WOF strips. Subcut (12) rectangles 2.5” x 8.5”

For Background Border: Cut Seven 4.25” WOF strips. Piece as needed

From the Accent Window Frame:

Cut six 2.5” WOF strips. Subcut (24) rectangles 2.5” x 8.5”

Cut eight 2.5” WOF strips. Subcut (24) rectangles 2.5” x 12.5”

For binding, cut seven 2.5" WOF strips

From featured Prints:

If you have quarter yard cuts:

Cut one 6.5" square, 1 Rectangle 4.5" x 8.5"

And one rectangle 4.5" x 12.5" Keep together as a set.

If you have half yard cuts, cut two sets of the above shapes from each print.
