



Class: Garden Lattice

Class Fee:

Skill Level: Medium Difficulty

Turn your favorite jelly roll into this quilted version of flowers cascading through a garden lattice. There are so many techniques rolled into this one class: an expanded 9-patch block turned on point, sashing and cornerstones. We will be discussing how to cut and apply setting triangles. In addition, there will be a demonstration of how to use a directional print for these triangles. We will be cutting our strips in class with a Stripology ruler lesson. This is truly a class designed to expand your quilting skills!

Supplies and Materials:

Garden Lattice pattern

Jelly Roll with at least 32 strips that contrast well with your background

2  $\frac{3}{4}$  yards Background

1 yard accent fabric for cornerstones and binding

1  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards coordinating print for setting triangles (Can be directional!)

Thread to match background

5 yards backing

Sewing Machine in good working order, new needle, quarter inch foot

Basic Sewing Supplies

Rulers: 12.5" square.

Optional, but highly recommended: Stripology XL with GEasy stickers,  
long rectangle ruler 6.5" x 24" and 6.5" square ruler

Mat and Rotary Cutter with new blade

Best Press Starch

Pre-Class Homework:

From Background, cut:

Four 10.5" WOF strips, Sub cut into 80 rectangles 2" (not 2.5") x 10.5" place in baggie.

These rectangles are for your sashing.

Eighteen 2.5" WOF strips, sub cut into 288 squares 2.5" x 2.5" These squares are for block construction.

From Accent Fabric: Cut three 2" WOF strips. Sub cut into (49) 2" squares These are for sashing.

From Setting Triangle Fabrics:

Cut two 18" WOF strips. Sub cut four 18" squares (we will be doing further cuts on these in class)

Cut One 11" WOF strip. Sub cut two 11" squares (again, we will be doing further cuts on these in class)

Do not cut your strips, we will be cutting these in class.

The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- 1) To reserve a spot in a class you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration.
- 2) Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee.
- 3) Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior to class.
- 4) Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class. \* Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, books, rulers). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts.
- 5) You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund (your choice of a refund or store credit). If you are unable to make class and you cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor later.
- 6) There are no refunds for NO SHOWS.
- 7) Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified & all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- 8) Patterns, books, and handouts cannot be shared or photo-copied due to copyright laws.
- 9) Guests are not allowed in classroom.
- 10) All machine brands are welcome in our classroom.
- 11) A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at time of registration if you'd like to use one of our machines.
- 12) Your Sewing Machine must be in good working order, and you need to know how to thread it and operate it (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend "borrowing one from a friend who hasn't used it for years!" Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate it. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.

\*BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES: Scissors, pins, seam ripper, pen, paper, needles, thread, ruler, and thread. If you have supplies at home, bring them. Specialty items needed for class (pattern, book, fabric, ruler) must be purchased at The Cotton Blossom. Please make every effort to make supply purchases prior to class.
