

## HOLLY (LAP SIZE 70 X 84) Moderately Ambitious

Time for a bright Christmas quilt that features stars and twists. Using the Stripology squared ruler and a few cutting tricks, the triangles just appear!

This pattern reinforces precise trimming, a scant quarter inch seam allowance, piecing and pressing tips. Each block then interlocks with its neighbor to form a crisp and graphic whole. This is a "2 color" quilt, so pick out your favorite border print and then choose your 2 colors for the center.

## **Supplies and Materials Needed:**

"Stripology Quickies" by GE Designs

Stripology Squared Ruler. Also bring a small nonslip ruler to trim off 1/2"

**GEasy arrow stickers** 

60 mm rotary cutter (new blade) and mat

Sewing machine in good working order – new needle sz 14

Some sort of small stiletto to help feed angled seam allowances under the pressure foot.

This can be a purple "thang", a wooden skewer, or even the tip of your seam ripper.

Basic Sewing Supplies including mechanical pencil

Fine Sewing Pins (fork pins optional)

Thread to match your background

2 yards border fabric

2 ½ yards background

5 quarter yard cuts of red

5 quarter yard cuts of green

¾ yard binding

5 ¼ yards backing

## **Pre-Class Homework:**

Cut four 8 ½ squares from each of your 10 prints for a total of 40.

From Background:

Cut 10 strips at 8 ½". Subcut (40) 8 ½" squares

The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- 1) To reserve a spot in a class you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration.
- 2) Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee.
- 3) Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior to class.
- 4) Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class. \* Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, books, rulers). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts.
- 5) You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund (your choice of a refund or store credit). If you are unable to make class and you cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor later.
- 6) There are no refunds for NO SHOWS.
- 7) Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified & all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- 8) Patterns, books, and handouts cannot be shared or photo-copied due to copyright laws.
- 9) Guests are not allowed in classroom.
- 10) All machine brands are welcome in our classroom.
- 11) A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at time of registration if you'd like to use one of our machines.
- 12) Your Sewing Machine must be in good working order, and you need to know how to thread it and operate it (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend "borrowing one from a friend who hasn't used it for years!" Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate it. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.

\*BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES: Scissors, pins, seam ripper, pen, paper, needles, thread, ruler, and thread. If you have supplies at home, bring them. Specialty items needed for class (pattern, book, fabric, ruler) must be purchased at The Cotton Blossom. Please make every effort to make supply purchases prior to class.
