**\*NOTE\*** This is labeled as a beginner skill level, however, you should have a basic knowledge of sewing and your machine. This basic knowledge should consist of knowing how to thread, wind bobbin, and the functionality of your machine.

*Items needed for the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, pattern, rulers, specialty thread, book, ect.). If you have basic sewing supplies and they are not listed below, please bring those (pins, scissors, seam ripper, needles, thread, ect.)*

Class Description: Every bible deserves a cover, and every book deserves a home. In this class, you will learn basic sewing skills and self quilting skills, and you will leave with a bible cover of your own!

We will be working with the "Selah Sleeve: A Bible Cover" pattern.

**Supplies Needed:**

**YOUR BIBLE/BOOK OF CHOICE**

5 fabrics of choice

- ½ yard for *Main Fabric*
- ½ yard for *Lining Fabric*
- ½ yard for *Binding* (Can add a ½ yard to either of the other four fabrics if you like best)
- ¼ yard for *Secondary Fabric*
- ¼ yard for *Accent Fabric*

½ yard of *Batting* or *Soft&Stable* (If you want more of a "puff" look, *Soft&Stable* is more preferable)

Thread to match/complement

Rotary cutter

6in" x 24in" ruler for cutting and measuring

Cutting Mat

Marking utensil

Pins/Clips

Seam Ripper

Basting Spray

**Optional (But not necessary):**

Scissors

Best Press

Measuring tape

Mini Iron

## The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- 1) To reserve a spot in class, you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration
- 2) Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee
- 3) Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior class
- 4) Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class. \*Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, rulers, books). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts
- 5) You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund (Your choice of a refund or store credit). If you are unable to make class and you can cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor later.
- 6) There are no refunds for NOW SHOWS
- 7) Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is canceled due to low enrollment, you will be notified and all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit)
- 8) Patterns, books, and handouts cannot be shared or photo copy due to copywriter laws.
- 9) Guests are not allowed in the classroom.
- 10) All machine brands are welcomed in our classroom.
- 11) A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at time of registration if you'd like to use one of our machines.
- 12) Your sewing machine must be in good working order, and you need to know how to thread it and operate it (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend "borrowing one from a friend who hasn't used it for years!" Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate it. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.
