



Class: Urban Nine Patch

Skill Level: Confident Beginner 

Items needed for class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, patterns, rulers, books, specialty thread, etc). If you have basic sewing supplies and they are not listed below, please bring those (pins, scissors, seam ripper, needles, thread, etc.).

Class Description: Welcome to a fun and moderately challenging class. You will use the Quick Curve Ruler to create a modern twist on a traditional block. Get ready to sew curves without pins! This pattern has built in trimming to help you create beautiful blocks. The Urban Nine Patch builds on the skills learned in the Urban Abacus class. If you did not attend the Urban Abacus – do not worry – you can still attend and Brooke will make sure you are up to speed!

We will make a practice block from scrap fabric before creating a block for your quilt.

Supplies Needed:

- ⇒ Urban Nine Patch Pattern
- ⇒ Quick Curve Ruler
- ⇒ 2 yards (sharks teeth on the class sample or black in the pattern)
- ⇒ 3 ½ yards background (light gray on class sample or green in the pattern)
- ⇒ 1 ¼ yards 9 patch (Red on the class sample or orange in the pattern)
- ⇒ ¾ yards 9 patch (Black on the class sample or white in the pattern)
- ⇒ ¾ yard for Traditional Binding OR ½ yard each for outer and flange for faux flange binding
- ⇒ PRACTICE PIECES!
- ⇒ Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- ⇒ Square ruler to square up 8" squares and 12 ½" squares
- ⇒ 4 ½" Block loc or similar size small square ruler to square up 3 ¼" half square triangles
- ⇒ Glo Line Tape
- ⇒ Cutting mat
- ⇒ Coordinating Thread
- ⇒ Marking pen or pencil that will show up on your fabric

■ Read the Pattern

- From the Black (sharks teeth on sample) cut
 - 6 – 8 ½" WOF subcut into 25 – 7 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles for curves
 - 5 – 3 ¼" WOF subcut into 50 – 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" squares for HSTs
- From the Green (gray on sample) cut
 - 7 – 8 ½" WOF subcut into 100 – 3" x 8 ½" rectangles for inner curve
 - 5 – 8 ½" WOF subcut into 100 – 2" x 8 ½" rectangles for outer curve
 - 5 – 3 ¼" WOF subcut into 50 – 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" squares for HSTs
- From the Orange (red on sample) cut
 - 9 – 3 ¼" WOF subcut into 100 – 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares for nine patch
 - 2 – 2 ½" WOF subcut into 25 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares for nine patch center
- From White (black on sample) cut
 - 7 – 3 ½" WOF subcut into 100 – 2 ½" x 3 ½" squares for nine patch

FOR YOUR PRACTICE BLOCK PLEASE BRING:

- From the Black (sharks teeth on sample) cut
 - 1 - 7 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle for curves
 - 2 - 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" squares for HSTs
- From the Green (gray on sample) cut
 - 4 – 3" x 8 ½" rectangles for inner curve
 - 4 - 2" x 8 ½" rectangles for outer curve
 - 2 – 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" squares for HSTs
- From the Orange (red on sample) cut
 - 4 – 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares for nine patch
 - 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares for nine patch center
- From White (black on sample) cut
 - 4 – 2 ½" x 3 ½" squares for nine patch

The Cotton Blossom Fabric Shoppe Class Policy:

- 1) To reserve a spot in a class you must pre-register in store or online. All fees are required at time of registration.
- 2) Most classes require supplies in addition to the instruction fee.
- 3) Typically, there is not enough time prior to class to shop for the class, so we ask that you purchase all fabric and supplies at least one day prior to class.
- 4) Basic sewing supplies will be needed for each class. * Supplies specific to the class must be purchased from The Cotton Blossom (fabric, books, rulers). A supply list will be available at registration. Our expertise in coordinating fabrics and selecting proper tools is part of your lesson before class starts.
- 5) You must cancel more than 7 days prior to class for a refund (your choice of a refund or store credit). If you are unable to make class and you cancel within 7 days of the class, the class fee is non-refundable. However, we are happy to offer a spot in another class with the same instructor later.
- 6) Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified & all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- 7) Patterns, books, and handouts cannot be shared or photo-copied due to copyright laws.
- 8) Guests are not allowed in the classroom.
- 9) All machine brands are welcome in our classroom.
- 10) A limited number of classroom machines are available for use. Please indicate at the time of registration if you'd like to use one of our machines.
- 11) Your Sewing Machine must be in good working order, and you need to know how to thread it and operate it (except when noted in beginner sewing class). It is suggested that if you have not used your machine in a while, you should have it serviced. We do not recommend "borrowing one from a friend who hasn't used it for years!" Our teachers cannot use valuable class time to try and repair or figure out how to operate it. If you have unforeseen problems with your machine during class, we are happy to let you borrow one of our machines when available.

*BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES: Scissors, pins, seam ripper, pen, paper, needles, thread, ruler, and thread. If you have supplies at home, bring them. Specialty items needed for class (pattern, book, fabric, ruler) must be purchased at The Cotton Blossom. Please make every effort to make supply purchases prior to class.
