

## BASIC SERGER CLASS TOOLS

Here is a list of basic serger tools that you should bring to any serger class:

- “Basic sewing supplies” - Anything you consider basic that you might need in class
  - Scissors and snips
  - Marking pens/pencils
  - Seam ripper
  - Straight pins
  - Clips
  - Fabric turner
  - Rotary cutter with extra blades
  - Cutting mat
  - Ruler 6” x 24”
  - Tweezers
  - Double eyed needle
  - Serger threads\*
    - 4 Serger thread cones
    - 4 spools of 12wt threads to coordinate with your fabrics
- \*Note: you will also want to bring 2 spools of 12wt black and 2 spools of 12wt white for contrast

## BASIC MACHINE TOOLS

- Threading chart
- Accessory compartment accessories:
  - screw driver/allen wrench,
  - needle threader,
  - needle inserter tool,
  - etc.
- Cutting door (this is the standard door for serging)
- Flat-bed cover stitch sewing table with screws
- Power cord/foot control
- Telescoping thread guide for 8 thread machine
- Extra needles:
  - ELx705 sizes 80/12 and 90/14
