

Not to mention the world’s second-largest boiling lake (due to geothermal volcanic activity).

Dominica is home to many cetaceans commonly seen in the area such as sperm whales, spinner dolphins, spotted dolphins and bottlenose dolphins. Along with this larger life you can expect to see turtles, sea horses and other fine aquatic specimens.
