Club Q



If you haven't been to Club Q, you are missing out on lots of fun! We have 2 different sessions for Club Q— the <u>first</u> Tuesday night at 6:00pm or the <u>first</u> Saturday morning at 10:30am. Depending on how dates fall, will depend on which session is first. There is no charge or registrations required to attend Club Q.

In August we featured some fun and easy ideas for placemats. We demonstrated easy turned and stitched, easy mitered placemats, denim rag placemats and also scalloped edge placemats.

If you missed Club Q, we so still have some of the patterns for the easy mitered and for the scalloped ones. Here are the measurements for the denim rag ones. If you have lots of old jeans, these are fun and easy to

make!

- Cut 2 pieces of denim and 2 pieces of cotton 4 1/2" x 13"
- Cut 1 piece of denim and 1 piece of cotton 11" x 13"
- Stitch the denim wrong sides together to the cotton with an X or straight lines. This is a great place to use decorative thread and those fun decorative stitches on your machines.
- Sew the 2 smaller pieces to the side of the larger piece with 1/2" seams. Denim sides together so the seam allowance is on the cotton fabric side.
- Clip the seam allowances about every 1/4" to 3/8".
- Wash & dry placemats.

Don't miss out on Club Q in September and October. <u>NOTE!!! In October we will have the Saturday session on the 2nd Saturday since Shop Hop falls on the first Saturday.</u>



Horizontally Challenged?


There are so many cool panels out there these days. Many of the new ones are horizontal, and sometimes it's hard to decide how to use these. One of our customers, Sylvia Griggs, made a fun tote bag out of our new cardinal panel. So we've been playing and have made a few samples! We are working on creating a pattern as well.

If you've been looking for a fun tote, check our panels. A 24" panel also makes a great tote bag for the 18" x 24" acrylic slide on tables that quilters bring to classes. Just sew the bottom narrow and Voila! You can create handles from the leftover backing fabric or use normal webbing for handles.

Organize and Store Your Fabric

Does it make you happy when all your fabric is stored neatly on a shelf? Then you pull one out, it's siblings on either side come with it, and pretty soon it's a messy stack. Solve this with the use of hanging file crates and hanging folders. It works great for fabrics that are the 42"/45" width. The other nice thing is that you can easily see all your fabrics and even if you have a small amount, it is visible. It doesn't get buried in a stack. Here's how to do it:



- Cut the file folders in half to that you have two halves.
- Fold your fabric in half lengthwise with selvages together and press.
- Fold again lengthwise so the fold is even with the selvaged edge and press.
- Fanfold the fabric about every 18" then drape this over the file folder and hang in the crate.

You can store lots of yards on these, and if the file folder metal wants to sag because of you have larger amounts like 4+ yards, just add a couple more single pieces and hang the fabric over 2 or 3 folders. If you do a good job squaring up the fabric as you press it, it is ready to come off the folder and be ready to cut. The nice thing is the smaller pieces are all level at the top.











School is In and sew are classes!

We have several fun classes coming up at the shop. The website has the most current list of classes and supplies. For the majority of the classes, the supply lists will give you the amount of fabric needed for the class. You can choose your own, or sometimes we might have kits available as an option.

The technique type classes will typically come with a kit instead of a supply list. This is because for the technique class, the fabrics are typically used for learning and practicing the technique.

An example of this would be the Frost

Free Flower Class we had. All of the fabrics in the kit are pre-fused and precut, ready to make the flowers.

Remember to hold your spot you will need to register and pay for the class. You can either pay in store or online at www.sewin2quilts.com.

If you are unable to attend, we will refund class fees if you notify us 24 hours in advance or 48 for a Monday Class.
