

EMBROIDERED HOT AIR BALLOON SUPPLY LIST

FABRIC

You will need to pick the number of fabrics you want to use, The balloon has 8 sides.

*You will need to use a stabilizer on the back of each fabric: The OESD pattern recommends OESD stabilizer. I use Shape Flex bought and the Sewing Center. I have used this on all my FSL items. The choice is up to you. This must be attached to the back of each fabric before class.

NOTIONS & TOOLS

- *40wt Polyester embroidery thread to match each fabric plus thread for the hanging lace around the balloon
- *Bobbins wound with each thread
- *Applique scissors—I find the ones that come with your Janome machine work the best but you may use whichever scissors you wish
- *Alligator clamps (optional)
- * Button clips (optional)

Reading glasses if you need them

MACHINES & ACCESSORIES

- *Embroidery machine with power cord in good working condition
- *A new Blue Tip needle size 11 (plus backups)
