**FABRICS & MATERIALS:**

- Fabric – Pre-Treated and ironed – see back of pattern for yardage amounts needed
- Interfacing – in an amount sufficient for your project

**NOTIONS & TOOLS**

- \* Scissors
- \* Pins
- \* Marking pencils/pens appropriate for your fabric
- \* Pattern Paper – Pellon 830 suggested
- \* Ruler – I recommend a 18” plastic ruler with blue grid
- \* Thread
- \* Bobbins
- \*\*\*Map Pins to secure the pattern to the form-core board. Office Depot has these pins.
- \*\*\*Form core board - available at Hobby Lobby
- Hand sewing needle if you are doing view A
- Buttons
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Reading glasses if needed

**MACHINE & ACCESSORIES**

- Sewing Machine
  - Suggested Feet: Straight and Buttonhole
- Serger

\* Items in Red are optional. I find when I copy a pattern securing it to the form-core board makes it easier to copy.
