FABRIC

* Three 14 in. x 17 in practice quilt sandwiches (we recommend using muslin or other plain fabric with 100% cotton or 80/20 batting) – Kits available

NOTIONS & TOOLS

* Book – “The Ultimate Guide to Rulerwork Quilting” by Amanda Murphy

* Rulers (optional – use ours!)

* 40 weight thread to contrast with your fabrics (Isacord-recommended)

* Snips or small scissors

* Quilting gloves (if you have them-optional)

* Marking pens or chalk pencils (we recommend Frixion pens)

* 1in x 12 in plastic ruler

* tweezers (optional)

* Slider mat (optional-but recommended)

* 505 spray – to make quilt sandwiches

Pen/pencil

Notepad

Reading glasses if you need them

MACHINES & ACCESSORIES

* Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

* Size 14 needles

* Ruler foot – for your machine

* Extension table if you have one

Sewing machine manual

BEFORE THE FIRST CLASS

- Assemble your 3 quilt sandwiches we recommend spray basting
- Put in a new size 14 needle
- Wind at least 2 bobbins of your chosen thread
- Attach your Ruler foot and tighten the thumb screw
