Finished size 52" x 191/2"

*SERGE IT! TABLE RUNNER pattern

FABRIC—See next page for fabric requirements for different sized Bed Runners (5) ½ yd. each coordinating fabrics for the runner (A, B, C, D, E)—If using directional prints or pattern matching, extra fabric may be needed. If you plan to repeat one fabric for two different areas (as seen on cover), purchase double the amount of that fabric.

1 ½ yd fabric for the backing (F)

*53" x 21" low loft batting—temporary adhesive spray if using non-fusible batting

NOTIONS & TOOLS

*Two (2) or three (3) colors decorative threads for flatlocking and finishing the outer edges.

Suggested: (12wt threads for flatlocking and 12 weight or 8 weight to finish outer edges.)

*Three (3) serger cone threads)—coordinating color

*Wonder clips or pins

Optional: 2 yds each of two (2) colors 1/4" wide ribbon to weave through reverse flatlocking, 1/8" wide ribbons for basket weaving.


*Bodkin or upholstery needle for weaving

MACHINES & ACCESSORIES

- *Serger in good working condition with power cord and foot control
- *Topstitch needle size 90/14 or 80/12
- *Universal needle size 90/14 or 80/12
- *Available for purchase from Sewing Center of Santa Fe

Finished sizes of Table or Bed Runners is 20" - 21" by: Table=52", Twin=52", Full= 64" - 68", Queen= 74" - 76", and King= 88"- 90". Your <u>batting and backing</u> need to be at least 20" - 21" by 52", 68", 76" or 90".



The turquoise Table Runner I used a patterned fabric for fabric D and with the red/gold Table Runner, I used the patterned fabric in the E area like the original pattern. I did not serge the outer edges. I used regular batting and decorative stitching to keep the layers together in the turquoise sample, and fusible batting with the red/gold sample.

- Fabric A you'll need 1/3 yard for Twin, Double or Queen and 1/2 yard for King.
- Fabric B you'll need 1/3 yard for all sizes.
- Fabric C1 (closer to the center) is 1/6 yard for Twin, Double, or Queen, and 1/4 yard for King.
- Fabric C2 is 1/6 yard for Twin, 1/4 yard for Full, Queen, & King. Note: I used the same width of the piping as the C1 fabric.
- Fabric D you'll need ¼ yard for Twin, 1/3 yard for Full or Queen and ½ yard for King.
- Fabric E ½ yard for Twin or Full, 2/3 yard for Queen, and 3/4 yard for King.

Cutting the fabric prior to class will help to keep the class on time. If you are using the same fabric for two locations, cut the longer/larger pieces first. I used the same fabric for Fabric A and E in the red/gold runner.
