PATTERN: The Sewing Workshop Chicago Jacket

This class will address the construction of the Chicago Jacket

Preparation to be completed before class:

• Have your pattern cut into individual pattern pieces and ironed

o I highly recommend you write your name on each pattern piece, instruction booklet and the envelope.

- Prepare your fabric:
 - Prewash & dry
 - Iron your fabric before coming to class

FABRICS & INTERFACING

- See "Fabric Requirements" on page 1 and Page 3 of instruction booklet
- Remnant of light weight fusible interfacing (we will use this for reinforcing purposes)

NOTIONS & TOOLS

- Cutting scissors
- Trimming scissors
- Thread
- Pins
- Tape measure: We will use this to position the pattern pieces on the grainline.
 - Please do not rely on someone else having a tape measure.
- Seam gauge
- Sean ripper
- Marking pencils appropriate for your fabric
- Notions: See back of pattern: 1" button, thread, fusible interfacing

MACHINES

- Sewing Machine in good working order with power cord and foot control
 - Straight stitch foot
 - Buttonhole foot
 - Overcasting foot for finishing seams
- Stand-alone Serger for finishing seams if you prefer
